Contexte

Created in 2022, Asbestonomy's mission is to reduce the risks of asbestos exposure worldwide. As simple as it may seem, this ambition is still far from being achieved. Asbestos has not yet been banned worldwide!

Today, millions of people around the world are exposed to asbestos fibres at work or in their daily lives, sometimes unknowingly.

And even in countries that have banned asbestos, this mineral fibre - invisible to the naked eye - continues to cause enormous damage.

With our range of different backgrounds and experiences, we know that these exposures are easily avoidable. Reducing the risk of exposure could save millions of lives in the years to come.



Definitions and challenges :

The suffix -nomy comes from Greek and means distribution, organisation (arrangement) and management. Specifically, it denotes a system of rules, laws or knowledge, often linked to science.

Asbestonomics is defined as the science of asbestos, with its system of knowledge organised and distributed at international level, in order

to better manage the risk of asbestos and thus reduce the risk of exposure.

Asbestonomy therefore gathers, creates, stimulates and processes knowledge about asbestos in order to effectively improve the skills of asbestos risk management stakeholders throughout the world.

Our areas of interest :

- **The effects of asbestos on human health :** a better understanding of the different mechanisms involved to provide better protection.
- **Asbestos in the workplace :** an inventory of the different methods and tools available to reduce the risk: from on-site management to removal and disposal.
- **Asbestos in the environment :** both in its natural and processed state, to better understand its environment in order to be able to control it.
- **Research and development, innovation :** studying new methods, knowledge and innovations aimed at preventing asbestos risks

Our different operating methods

The Asbestonomy community recognises the value of sharing knowledge. We provide practical tools that enable us to capitalise intelligently on our knowledge and know-how by creating know-how by creating synergies within the Asbestonomy club.

- An exhibition area packed with innovations and solutions.

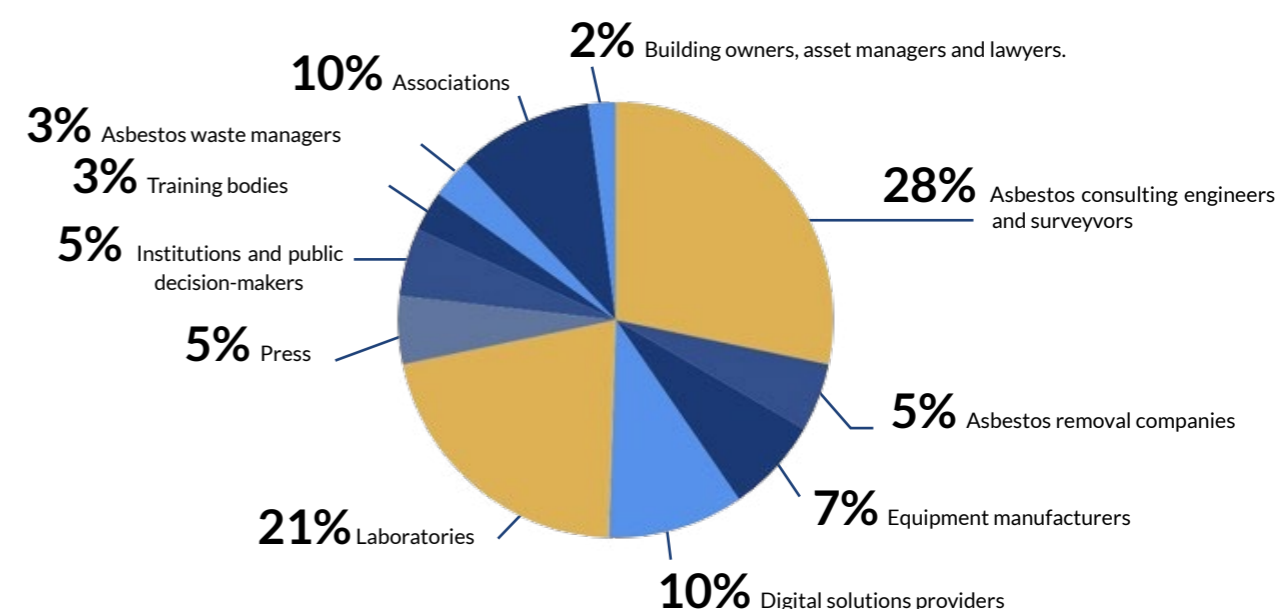

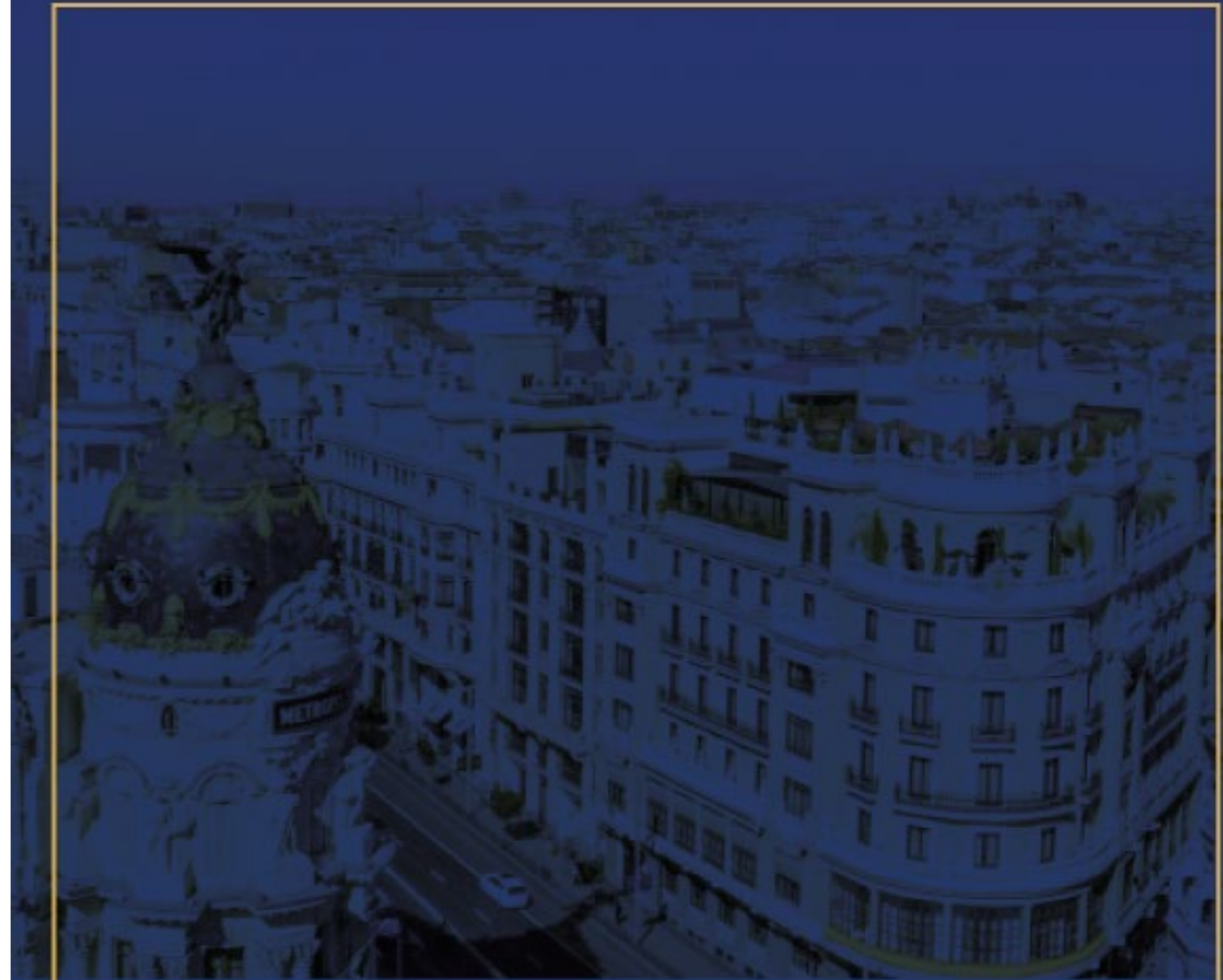
